Staffing

This year, staffing has seen many interruptions due to the Board's failure to publish the admin placements by the end of April and the complications due to the ARC process. One of the grievance resolutions allows

for a pause in Phase Two until after the ARC decisions on the 19^{th} and the admin placement announcement on the 20^{th} . Mobility applications will be received with Phase Two applications and again on June 20^{th} , and mobility moves will be made on the 21^{st} (as well as contractual increases). Another resolution to the admin placement grievance will result in all mid-year vacancies next year being filled by the JSC in the same manner as the current Phase One/Two process. No interviews, resumes, and covering letters will be required next year.

Stewards will be asked to check with all staff members, including those on leave, to ensure that everyone has completed the registration. Failure to sign up by July 1, could mean denial of coverage under the new plan.

LTD
